14.03.2023 | WARSAW, POLAND

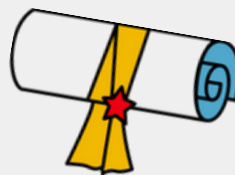
On the 14th of March 2023, we had our final partners meeting, hosted by the University of Social Sciences in their premises in Warsaw.

Cultural Centres for Sustainable Development - from the Grassroots to the EU Level, we gathered young entrepreneurs, members of different associations, and educators in the field of culture. The partners presented all the results developed in the project. Participants and experts on the topics discussed how cultural entrepreneurship can strengthen local communities and increase community capacity. They also had the chance to improve their entrepreneurship and digital competencies during the workshops.
